

# SHOP SAFELY AT SHOWTIME

ITA has been working with multi-tenant buildings and standalone showrooms to ensure that our attendees can safely shop at Showtime on November 14-17, 2021. The following precautions will be taken by **all buildings** and **standalone showrooms**:

### FACE COVERING

- As mandated by the Guilford County Board of Commissioners, masks will be required indoors, regardless of vaccination status.
- Those without a face covering will be provided with one.

### MONITORING OF ATTENDEE HEALTH

- Temperature checks are no longer required.
- If you have recently been exposed to COVID-19, have symptoms, or are not feeling well please stay home to protect yourself and others.

## **CLEANING & SANITATION**

- High touch surfaces will be disinfected often throughout the day using EPA approved disinfectants
- Hand sanitizer containing 60% alcohol will be readily available at registration, elevators and throughout the buildings

### SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Social distancing will be encouraged in common areas.
- Signage has been installed throughout common areas to indicate appropriate spacing for registration and elevators.
- Showroom capacity limits have been lifted. Exhibitors will manage capacity to their own comfort level

## REGISTRATION

- $\circ$   $\;$   $\;$  Pre-registration is strongly encouraged to prevent lines at onsite registration.
- Three separate registration areas will be available at Market Square Market Square First Floor entrance, Market Square Second floor entrance and Market Square Courtyard.

### TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING

- o Courtesy shuttle service will be offered between multitenant buildings.
- o Drivers and passengers will be required to wear masks in shuttle vans.
- Shuttles will be sanitized regularly throughout the day or after each trip.
- $\circ$   $\;$  The airport courtesy shuttle will not be offered at November Showtime.

### **CATERING AND FOOD**

- Self-service buffets are once again allowed. Guests must wear a mask while going through the buffet line.
- Disposable single-use plates and cups must be used.
- All utensils must be plastic, disposable and individually wrapped.
- As much as practicable, all beverages must be individually packaged.

\*High-risk individuals are encouraged to stay home.
